Post-construction Update. The third bell for the bell tower will be installed this Tuesday, October 21st by McShane Bell Foundry following the 10:00 AM Divine Liturgy. Before it is installed, it will be consecrated and given the name "Miriam Teresa", the first American Byzantine Ruthenian to be beatified. The other two bells are named "Theodore" and "Paul" for Blessed Theodore Romzha and Blessed Paul Gojdich two of our martyred bishops of Europe. Bells are consecrated in a rite that emulates baptism and chrismation. The bell is blessed with holy water and then anointed with sacred Chrism that is used for the Sacrament of Confirmation/Chrismation. Parishioners can participate in the rite.
